
WEATHER FX ON PLANTS-

The weather conditions of the 2021 season were favourable to the early ripening of the pods in general and this regardless of the territory. However, while the blows were going well on the north shore of the St. Lawrence River, the occasional rains received each week of September on the southwest, even though they left only a few mm of rain each time, put a brake on to start beating in good conditions.

DEVELOPMENT STAGE





CROP MANAGEMENT-

Weed control has not met the expectations of farmers this year. Of those that were problematic, the black nightshade in America is certainly the one that had the most impact on grain quality for a grade of #1 soybean intended for human consumption. The presence of these ripe fruits in some harvested soybean lots contributed significantly to the increase in the % of spotted kernels. Nevertheless, the majority of producers have managed to produce a food grade soybean that meets industry standards.

ORGANIC CROP-

The first early freezes have not yet occurred in the territories of southwestern Quebec and north of the St. Lawrence River. Since a good concentration of organic soybean production occurs on the north shore of the St. Lawrence, we should expect to receive slightly more stained soybean lots than what we consider to be the "limit" for food grade #1.
