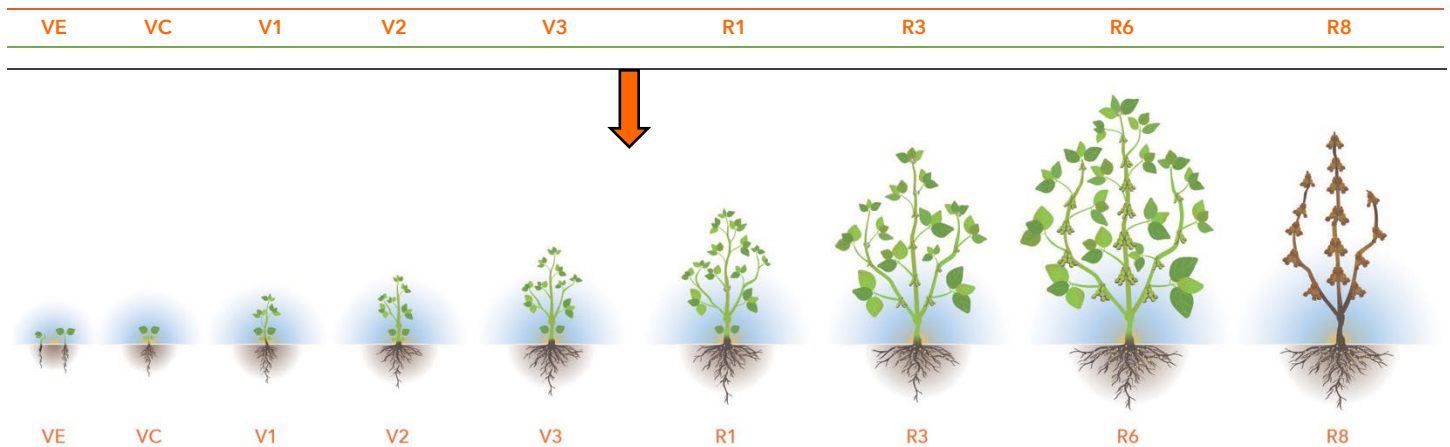
GLOBALLY

The month of May was dry, but overall, all the soybean planted mid may and at the end of May, looking good for Quebec and Eastern Ontario. The emergence was not the best for the soybean planted at the beginning of June. The last planting soybean done in June waited 3 weeks in the ground to finally emergence after the first rain. We only got 2-3 replants because of the bad emergence, so we can say it is a good year.

The first soybean flower has been seen the July 1st,

Weed control was difficult again this year because of the lack of rain in May. Lot of the growers had to be spray twice to control lamb's quarter.

First aphids also had been seen on July 1st, we wish that we will have less than last year, and it will not impact yield like last year.
