GLOBALLY

Overall the soybean crop looks good heading into the final pod filling stages. The month of July was extremely wet here in Western Ontario with some areas having over 200mm of rain in July alone. This caused some fields to have drowned out areas as well as increased presence of root rots. We are also about 10% lower on heat units compared to average which is delaying the reproductive stages of the crops. Soybeans are much taller than they were last year due to a lot of vegetative growth but early pod counts show high yield potential if the weather cooperates and diseases don't take over.
