GLOBALLY

In this month of October, the soybean harvest is around 65-70 % for the different eastern territories. The rain of the last few days has slowed down the harvest. Yields are satisfactory overall except for less well-drained lands that received more precipitation. Weeding is also one of the criteria influencing yields this year. This week, with the good weather and the small amounts of rain received over the last few days, should be conducive to the progress of the harvests. To date, thanks to the good conditions of recent weeks, producers have been able to harvest good quality soybean.
