**GLOBALLY**

The month of August showed below average temperatures across Manitoba from the beginning to middle of the month, with a big temperature spike in the last week in August that greatly helped the progression of the soybean crop. Most areas of the province received above average moisture to really help pod development in the crop. Soybeans are roughly 10-14 days from harvest in Eastern MB and 14-20 days away from harvest in Western MB. We can expect to see average to above average yields for this upcoming harvest.
